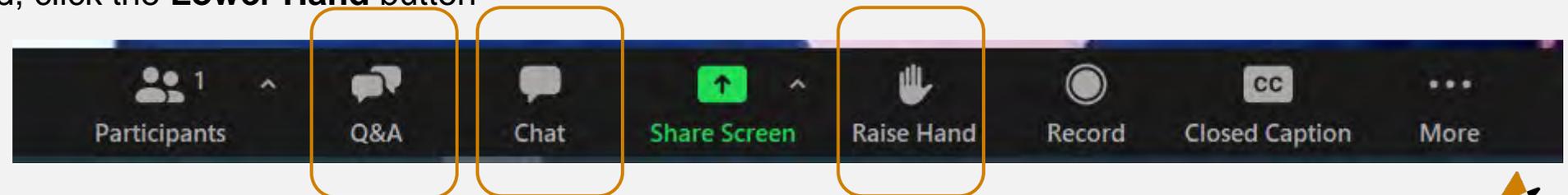
- Click the **Q&A button** to open the window

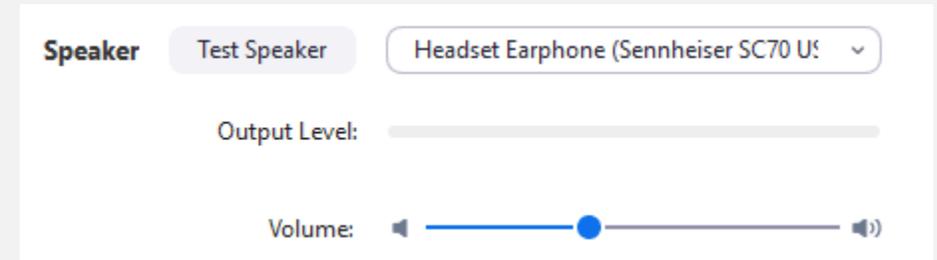
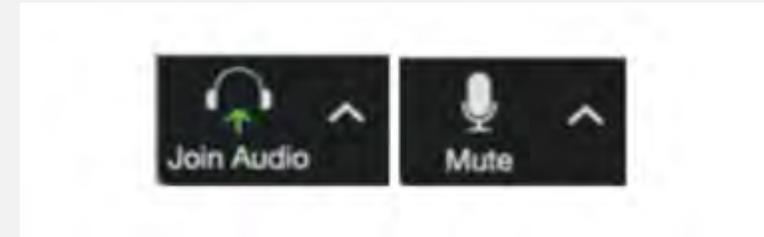
- Click the **Raise Hand** button at any time to indicate to the host know that you have a question or need assistance
