





# AP Automation Enhancements

- Enhanced AI and ML to predict GL account and other dimensions such as Location and Department values on a line-by-line basis.
- In the beginning, you may need to correct some predictions and then post changes, but this will help the AI/ML to build a model of what you expect.






# Easier access to payment files

- You may now generate and access payment files for ACH and bank file payments in AP, without needing to navigate to Cash Management.
- This is useful when you want your AP processing team to manage the payment workflow within AP, instead of accessing the Cash Management application.
- Permissions – Admins can give permissions to the Payment files submenu, by granting ACH or Bank file permissions to users in Cash Management.



# Restricted user behavior

- Sage Intacct has made some changes to restricted user behavior to enforce restrictions placed on users and protect data integrity.
- Approvals
  - Department-restricted users cannot approve or decline bills that contain line items coded to departments outside of their restrictions.
  - This change ensures that when users approve bills, they are doing so with full knowledge of all line items. This new functionality matches the existing behavior for entity-restricted users.
- Editing bills
  - Entity-restricted and department-restricted users cannot post edits to bills that contain line items outside their restrictions.

# Edit tax information for bills in draft state

- To help support AP Automation for companies using the Taxes application, Sage Intacct no longer validates tax fields while bills are in a draft state.
- This means that you can continue to work on a bill and save your progress before you select a tax solution or provide tax details. You can also change this information before you post the bill. The tax solution, tax details and the vendor are validated when you post the bill.

# Memo reclassification change

- When you reclassify a bill and change the memo, the memo is now updated on the corresponding bill payment in addition to the bill.
- Note: If the bill was posted to a period that is now closed, you cannot update the memo field.



# Draft payments not ready to post

- Sage Intacct is introducing more flexibility with customer payments.
- You may now draft customer payments that you're not ready to post, giving you flexibility to come back to the payment and verify or make changes before you post to the subledger.
- This is especially useful when payments were imported or synced in bulk.
- You may also post payments in bulk from the Posted payments lister page. If you no longer need a draft, you can simply delete it from the list.



# Restricted user behavior

- Similarly to AP, in AR, Sage Intacct has made some changes to restricted user behavior to enforce restrictions placed on users and protect data integrity.
- Editing bills
  - Entity-restricted and department-restricted users cannot post edits to AR invoices that contain line items outside their restrictions.
  - This change ensures that users are allowed to modify only transactions for which they have full visibility.

# Bank transaction assistant for file imports—Generally available

- There's a new way to import your bank transactions for reconciliation that focuses on flexibility, control, and visibility and it's now generally available.
- This import experience takes the place of the classic import process. You can use one method or the other, but not both at the same time.

## Details

Bank transaction assistant for file imports introduces a fresh approach to importing.


- Imported transactions appear in a centralized location for all bank accounts on the Bank Transactions page.
- Transactions you import remain in Sage Intacct, even after reconciliation.
- More file formats are supported, giving you extra flexibility (XLS, XLSX and OFX).
- You can increase control of who imports bank transactions using permissions.
- A new import activity list provides added insight.

# Improve your workflow with bank transaction assistant

- Easily and quickly assign customers to bank transactions and then receive multiple payments for multiple customers, all from the Bank Transaction page. After you receive payments, the posted payments in Sage Intacct and the bank transactions automatically match for reconciliation.
- For multi-entity, multi-currency companies, receive advances and payments at the entity level.

# Improve your workflow with bank transaction assistant

### Receive payments in bulk

- When a bank transaction has a customer assigned, you can receive a payment or create an advance. You can also receive payments in bulk. If there's no invoice for the customer, you can create an advance using the new AR advances template.

To receive payments from bank transactions, you'll need the new Cash Management permission **Receive payments from bank transactions**.

# Run a reconciliation match sequence report

- Sage Intacct recently introduced match sequences to bring visibility into your bank and credit card reconciliation matches. Now, you can run a pre-built custom report to see which Sage Intacct transactions matched to which bank transactions.

## Details

- Run the new Detail of Reconciliation Matches report from the Custom report area. Set parameters for the bank account ID, the GL account, or look up matches by a specific sequence. You can also group by sequence number for easy visibility into which Intacct transactions matched with which bank transactions.
- In the report, you can view both the bank transaction and Intacct transaction, along with any available transaction details like Description or Bank record number.
- You can customize the report to get just the detail you want.

# Post opening balance entries to retained earnings when consolidating mid-year

- As a best practice, Sage Intacct recommends consolidating from the first period where you have business activity. For situations where you need to consolidate after the first period, Sage Intacct now separates opening balance entries from retained earnings.
- For consolidations that start after the first period with transactions, Sage Intacct now creates opening balance entries on balance sheet accounts, including retained earnings. This enables you to benefit from the clear, automated categorization and separation of opening balance from current period activity.

## Details

- You can run a General Ledger (GL) report on a consolidation book to observe the opening balance entries as separate from the consolidation entries.
- For example, the following table lists clearly distinct entries as they would appear in an Intacct GL report, such as:
  - Consolidation entries
  - Opening balance entries

# AR retainage release invoices now include project contract billing information

- When you release retainage invoices in AR, those invoices now include project contract billing information from the project or AR retainage task. This billing information will not appear on non-project contract invoices.

## Details

- In addition to the Project contract billing details tab on your Accounts Receivable (AR) retainage release invoices, you can now also see information, similar to an Order Entry (OE) project contract invoice:
  - External reference - Prefills from project contract. You can edit this information on your AR retainage release invoice.
  - Contract description - Prefills from project contract. You can edit this information on your AR retainage release invoice.
  - Contract date - Prefills from project contract. You can edit this information on your AR retainage release invoice.
  - Architect - Prefills from project contract. You can edit this information on your AR retainage release invoice.
  - Billing through date - For AR retainage release invoices, the billing through date prefills with the AR retainage release invoice date. You can change this information on your AR retainage release invoice. Then, recalculate the project contract billing totals linked to this AR retainage release invoice using the Update billing details totals button.
  - For AR retainage release invoices, you can save the Billing application value. The default value is blank.

# Override tax schedules in Purchasing and Order Entry for Construction

- You can override tax amounts and details in Purchasing and Order Entry to address unusual situations, but sometimes customers with interstate projects need more granular control. Now, companies subscribed to the Construction application and using Advanced Tax or a VAT tax solution can override the default tax schedule in transaction line items. This makes it easier to calculate taxes for transactions that cross tax jurisdictions.

## Details

- When you create or convert a Purchasing or Order Entry transaction, each line item is filled with the tax schedule associated with the vendor item or customer item. You can change the default tax schedule by selecting a new tax schedule in the tax schedule dropdown.
- For example, you have a vendor item that defaults to a Washington tax schedule, but the construction project needs to be taxed using Oregon rates. With this feature, you can override the default Washington Sales Tax schedule to the corresponding Oregon Sales Tax schedule.
- When you change the tax schedule, the totals recalculate automatically. If you have subtotals turned on, you must recalculate those manually.

— This feature is only available to companies with a Construction subscription that use Advanced Tax or a VAT tax solution.

# Store project and notes on corresponding compliance records

- You can now track compliance records related to a project. Use notes on compliance records to describe the project (job), vendor, or purchase order and subcontract. These notes are visible to all compliance record users.

## Details

- When you create a commitment, the project is now automatically included on the compliance record. You can easily add or change the project on the compliance record.
- In addition, you can include the project on your printed document templates.

# Work in progress (WIP) management—Early adopter

- Use WIP schedules to track overbilling and underbilling and show the predicted profit at the end of your project. WIP schedules are useful for project managers, controllers, CFOs and anyone monitoring the profitability of ongoing projects.

## Details

- CFOs and project managers can use the interactive reporting tool to enter their own project cost and revenue forecasts to go along with data pulled from Sage Intacct Construction. Values are pulled from:
  - Projects
  - Estimates
  - Contracts
  - Recorded costs
  - Customer billing
- Each WIP schedule covers a specific period. The WIP schedule periods are based on the reporting periods that you already have set up in your entity.
- Each row in the WIP projects section represents an ongoing project. Each column contains information for that project and the WIP schedule period.

# Improved insight into posted revenue exchange rates

- For contracts in multi-currency companies, Sage Intacct schedules revenue using the exchange rate associated with the contract line's exchange rate date. After the related billing is posted, any posted revenue amounts use the exchange rate associated with the invoice exchange rate date. Previously, the exchange rate associated with posted revenue was not easily viewable.
- You can now access a revenue schedule's multi-currency values in one place, giving you a more accurate reflection of a revenue schedule's current value at a glance. Get this big picture view by including the posted exchange rate and the posted base amount data in your custom reports based on the **Contract revenue schedule entry** report object.

# Improved insight into posted revenue exchange rates

## What's new

- Sage Intacct added the following fields to the **Contract revenue schedule entry** report object and to the **Revenue schedule** window in the user interface:
  - **Posted exchange rate:** Displays one of the following after the corresponding revenue is posted:
    - If the associated billing is not posted, this field displays the exchange rate associated with the contract line's exchange rate date.
    - After the associated billing is posted, this field displays the exchange rate from the associated invoice.
- **Posted base amount:** Displays the posted revenue amount expressed in the associated location's base currency.



# Create assets from purchasing transactions

### Details

- Sage Intacct checks if the items in a transaction are associated with an asset classification. This association is defined in the transaction definition's posting configuration.
- If a match is found, you provide a name for the new asset on that line item.
- When the transaction posts, it creates an AP bill, which then generates an asset. You can review the asset to add additional details.
- The new asset is automatically tagged as a dimension on the transaction, bill and posted journal entries.

# Improved workflow for non-depreciable assets

Sage Intacct introduced some changes to improve how you view and work with non-depreciable assets:

- Simplified your view by only showing the most important information.
- Added disposal detail fields so the information is easily accessible.
- Added an optional setting in configuration for selecting a disposal journal.

# Improved workflow for non-depreciable assets

### Details

On the Asset page, the following areas are no longer displayed for non-depreciable assets:

- Depreciable cost tile
- Depreciation rules section
- Depreciation schedules tab

In the Disposal details section of the Asset page, the following fields are now displayed for non-depreciable assets:

- Gain or loss amount
- Journal
- GL batch ID

Additionally, Sage Intacct added a new setting in Fixed Assets Management configuration. This setting allows you to assign a journal for the disposal of non-depreciable assets.

# Other updates in Fixed Assets Management

This release brings the following updates to improve your experience.

### User interface updates

Sage Intacct made the following changes to the Assets default list view:

- Added the Attachment column. Select the paperclip icon to view files attached to the asset.
- Added the When Created column, which displays the date the asset record was created.
- Updated the default sort order to show the most recently created assets at the top of the list. It now sorts by the “When created date” in descending order.

# Other updates in Fixed Assets Management

### Daily depreciation disposal calculations

- Sage Intacct updated their daily depreciation calculations to comply with laws governing fixed assets and depreciation in France and other regions.
- Before, when you disposed of an asset under the daily method, the asset did not depreciate in the month of disposal. Now, a new entry is added to the depreciation schedule and an additional depreciation expense GL batch is created to account for the partial accumulated depreciation in the month of disposal.





# Support for multiple transaction definition mappings per entity

- With automated transaction matching, you define how incoming purchasing documents map to existing source transactions in a one-time setup. Then, instead of converting purchasing transactions to vendor invoices, you let Sage Intacct match incoming vendor invoices using the following flow:
  - You email or upload vendor invoice documents for automated processing.







# Cash basis VAT capture for France

- Capture taxes for VAT reporting at the point of payment with cash basis VAT capture.
- By default, the Taxes application captures VAT or GST at the time an invoice or bill is issued, a process known as invoice basis tax capture. In entities using a French tax solution, you can choose instead to capture VAT or GST at the time an invoice or bill is paid. This process is known as cash basis tax capture.




# TVA Française addition

- To facilitate tax calculation and reporting, we added TVA Française to our list of standard tax solutions. The TVA Française tax solution provides an automated setup for the tax rates for domestic VAT in France.
- Using the TVA Française tax solution in one or more entities lets you access several other features exclusive to France, such as cash basis VAT capture and partial exemption. You can create tax submissions through Sage Regulatory Reporting and export your taxable transactions in the Accounting entries file (FEC) format.

The TVA Française tax solution setup automates domestic tax rates for France.




- UK – Sage Intacct updated the tax submission to account for transactions that are using Reverse charge in partially exempt transactions.
- South Africa - The **Offset credits on sales and purchases for VAT reporting** checkbox is available for entities in South Africa. It controls whether returns to suppliers and credits to customers are reported in the adjustment fields or as offsets in the input and output VAT fields on the VAT201 Declaration.
- Canada - The new printed invoice template for Canada lets you generate Accounts Receivable and Order Entry invoices so that they display the totals for PST and GST in the transaction currency rather than the base currency.
- Overall - To help support AP Automation for companies using the Taxes application, we no longer validate tax fields while bills are in a draft state.
- This means that you can continue to work on a bill and save your progress before you select a tax solution or provide tax details. You can also change this information before you post the bill. The tax solution, tax details and the vendor are validated when you post the bill.

# Partial exemption enhancements for France and the United Kingdom

- Capturing the appropriate taxes can be challenging when a portion of a purchase is exempt from taxation. With this enhancement, you can set partial exemption percentages at the tax detail level for entities operating in France or the United Kingdom. Then you can apply those partial exemptions to line items in Accounts Payable and Purchasing transactions.
- When you make an expenditure that qualifies for a tax credit, you can recover a percentage of the taxes paid on that expenditure. This is known as partial exemption.
- **Note:** You can only enter Bills with partial exemption line items at the entity level. If you're working at the top level, partial exemption line items do not apply.

# Updates to Taxable Payments Annual Report (TPAR) for Australia

- It's not too late to join our Early Adopter program for the Export TPAR file option. This option exports the TPAR file in a format that's ready to upload to the ATO.
- We adjusted how we calculate the **Gross amount paid** to align with Australian Tax Office (ATO) requirements.
- The following amounts **are** included in the **Gross amount paid** calculation:
  - Payments made against bills during the reporting period, not including any credits applied
  - Advances paid to the vendor to the vendor during the reporting period, whether or not they were applied
- The following amounts **are not** included in the **Gross amount paid** calculation:
  - Bill payments that were voided during the reporting period
  - Advances that were voided during the reporting period
  - Adjustments that were created and credit that was applied during the reporting period
  - Total tax withheld, as entered in the vendor information record

# Ability to distribute employee expenses

Sage Intacct now offers the ability to distribute employee expenses based on transaction allocations in an expense report. This allows you to distribute employee expenses quickly. You can distribute employee expenses and credit card transactions linked to an employee.

## Details

Previously, when you created an expense report, you would need to calculate the distribution and enter several lines for an expense item. Now, when you create an expense report, you can distribute the amount paid for a transaction. Sage Intacct calculates the amount to distribute between departments, cost centers, grants, programs, or classes. Intacct distributes the amount based on the transaction allocation.

- To distribute employee expenses, an admin must select the **Enable allocation to distribute expense entry** checkbox on the Configure Time and Expenses page.
- A transaction allocation determines how Intacct distributes the amount of an employee expense.
- Only use transaction allocations that are percentage based in an employee expense.

- When scheduling a report, you can now filter the report by project or project group. If you filter by project group, you can select **Individual report** to divide the report into separate sections for each project in the group.

# Improved financial reporting for projects

- In the Financial Report Writer, the **Project** filter (on the Filters tab) has a new **Run as individual reports** option. If you filter by all projects or by a project group, you can select this option to divide the report into separate sections for each project.

**Note:**

- Generating individual reports for each project in a group works for project groups with up to 500 projects.

# IVE workflow walk-throughs

Interactive Visual Explorer (IVE) enables you to explore data with visualizations that illustrate your data's story. The workflow tasks walk you through using calculations, creating filters, and applying different visualizations to analyze data from different perspectives. This capability allows you to fully explore correlations and patterns and discover trends.

### Details:

The following workflows walk you through creating visual boards, applying calculations and exploring the data with a variety of visualization types. Each workflow provides tasks that build on one another. It is recommended that you complete the workflows in the order listed.

- **Workflow 1: Report and chart visualizations** creates a Bills Analysis report visual board, applies calculations, and explores bar and donut chart visualizations.
- **Workflow 2: Table and chart visualizations** creates an Accounts Receivable table visual board, applies calculations, and explores scatter and pie chart visualizations.
- **Workflow 3: Pivot table and chart visualizations** creates a Bills Analysis Year over Year pivot table visual board, applies calculations, and explores combo, donut and display tile visualizations.



### Bulk import project percent complete information

- You can now upload a .csv file to update observed percent complete values in bulk. This ensures accurate data on dashboards and reports, including estimated efficiency calculations on the Project Analytics dashboards.
- You can use the Download Template link to download a file that contains the columns required for the import to succeed.

### Track operating costs

- Operating costs, covering non-labor expenses like billable materials, are now factored into both actual and estimated gross profit calculations across the Profitability and Project Analytics dashboards. Operating cost totals are also displayed on dashboard performance cards and reports.
- To omit operating costs from gross profit calculations and dashboards, do not assign accounts to the SI-Service Operating Costs unmanaged account group.







# Release retainage on prime invoices

- You can now release retainage on prime invoices. When you release the retainage on the invoice, the retainage amount is sent to Sage Intacct.
- In Sage Intacct, the following happens for the applicable line entries:
  - The **Retainage release line** checkbox is automatically selected.
  - The amount is entered in the **Retainage to bill this period** field.




# Enjoy more control: Exclude selected components when publishing applications

- In Customization packages, you can include Smart links, Smart rules and Smart events. In Platform applications, you can now exclude these components from a customization package.
- For example, you might have a package that you previously installed and want to add standard object customizations. With this update, you can do so and ensure that existing data in Smart rules, Smart events and Smart links are not lost.



# Audit Trail checkbox for system-generated object fields removed

- To improve usability, we removed the Audit Trail checkbox for system-generated object fields.
- We updated the edit page for object fields that are system-generated. The option to check **Track changes to this field in each record's Audit Trail for a complete historical log** no longer exists.
- This option still appears on object field pages for objects that are not system-generated.



# Improved functionality: No more Audit Log package installation

- You may now generate audit logs for object changes without needing to install the Audit Log package.
- To prevent conflicts with this new solution, Intacct now blocks the installation of the Audit Log package and prevents the execution of the events associated with it.
  - Any events associated with the former Audit Log package do not execute, and relevant logs reflect that the event is blocked. This enhancement means that you do not need an application package to add events to object changes. This change also means that you can more easily create audit reports and share them.
- When you create a Smart event, you no longer see an option to select **Log** from event properties. You can continue to select **Email**, **HTTP post**, or **API** for the event properties.
  - Instead, create a report based on the Audit Trail and add it to an application menu for easy access. See [Use an Audit Trail report](#) for instructions on how to set this up.



# Lists enhancements – Try it!


- Turn on the Lists beta interface to personalize your list views, leverage advanced filters, manage list and record details side-by-side, and much more.
- Try it on the Vendors list
  - Go to Accounts Payable > All tab > Vendors
  - Turn on Lists beta interface
- Personalize your list views while you work:
  - Add, move and resize columns
  - Freeze columns on the screen to preserve the view when scrolling
  - Sort columns by the data that means the most to you.
  - Save your customized views for future use.

# Lists enhancements – advanced filters

- With advanced filtering, you can easily narrow down your data. Advanced filtering works across columns and you can even save what you filter on into a custom view for repeated use.
- Some examples of advanced filtering:
  - Search for a range on date and amount fields
  - Combine multiple filter criteria using AND and OR operators
- View record details next to your list
  - Easily navigate the list records while viewing the record details side-by-side in a split view mode.
- Even more enhancements
  - The Lists enhancements have even more features, including:
  - Bulk operations
  - Improved organization and central management of list views
  - More colors for displaying your hierarchy
